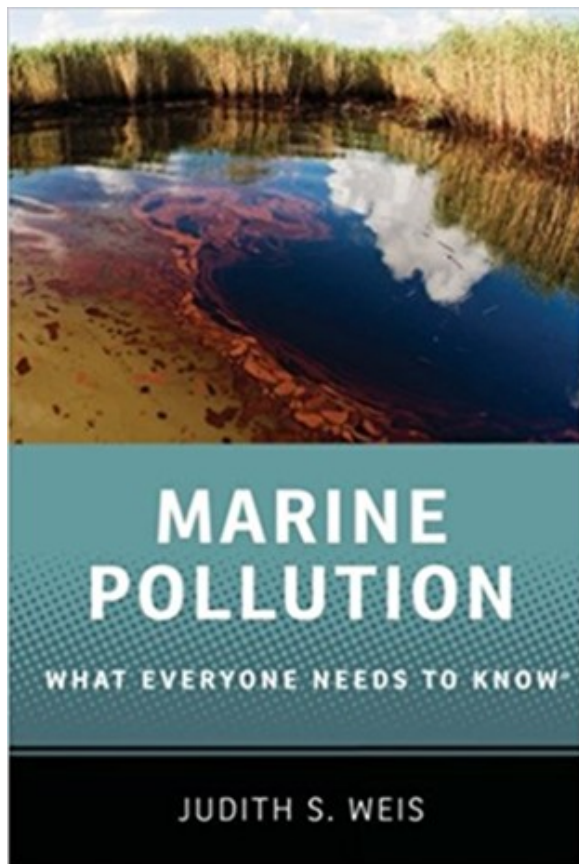




Marine Pollution: What Everyone Needs to Know

Based on my book, this illustrated talk will cover various types of pollution: nutrient pollution, plastics and other forms of trash, oil, toxic chemicals including metals and pesticides, emerging concerns such as pharmaceuticals and noise, biological pollution (e.g. invasive species), and climate change including ocean acidification. We will discuss the major sources of each type, effects on marine life, current trends and (for some) what *you* can do about it.
